The objective of the newly revised Chapter Achievement Awards is to recognize chapters for their exceptional work as it applies to ALL committees, and ALL chapter sizes. The amended point structure measures multiple benchmarks highlighting member involvement with the goal to encourage healthy sustainable chapters while promoting member retention and active participation. They serve as planning guides for individual and chapter participation in the, committee activities, programs, service projects and, monetary contributions

Each year's accomplishments are measured from January 1 through December 31. Watch for the 2022 CMR to be posted in August. Go ahead and get started as soon as you can. You can save your input, then re-open later for additions or editing. Now is the time to check out the 2022 Planning Guide and the 2022 Checklist, links are included below. Work with your committees to plan the goals you wish to achieve this year, and the activities in which your chapter will want to participate to reach these goals.

Note! In order to receive CAA credit, all chapter financial contributions must be sent through the State Treasurer.

The Chapter Master Report (CMR) is NOT a contest. It is a yearly reporting tool that allows National and State Chairs to recognize deserving chapter members' outstanding service.

The 2022 Checklist will also help you with planning for your chapter. An important deadline is that the National dues for your chapter must be postmarked no later than November 15, 2022 to receive credit. The Chapter Achievement form is a part of the Chapter Master Report and must be completed on-line through e-membership access. The deadline for submission is January 30, 2023. Paper copies will not be accepted.
