AIRS: Additional Information Requested. Letters written by staff genie requesting new or additional documents to prove lineage or service.

ATF: Application Task Force, formerly called the America 250! Membership task force. There are new rules regarding the process of requesting help from the ATF. Please read the Application Task Force info on members.dar.org

BAA: Build An App. Program used as a shortcut to a finished App using previously proven lineage. Always save to your computer before filling out the form.

E-apps: Electronic Applications, can't be used for new patriots, supplementals or applications that require a service study or an analysis. <u>Electronic Applications (eAPP) | Daughters of the American Revolution (dar.org)</u>

E-membership: Where you find the PMD, chapter rolodex, and lots of other information. YOU CANT BREAK IT! <u>e-Membership | Daughters of the American Revolution (dar.org)</u>

GEP: Genealogy Education Programs, coursework for ladies who wish to learn more about DAR genealogy standards.

LRC: Lineage Research Committee, your search assistants. This committee will help you find what you need to prove that tricky lineage or service. PM: prospective member, those lovely ladies who want to join your chapter and the DAR.

PMD: Prospective Member Database. This very important database tracks the progress of the prospective member to verification of her national number. <u>Prospective Member Database (PMD) | Daughters of the American Revolution</u> (dar.org)

SAT: State Application Team. A team of VGs who prepare apps for PMs who fill out the interest form on the dar.org website. They help take some of the load off the chapter registrar. <u>State Application Team (SAT) | Daughters of the American Revolution (dar.org)</u>

SMRT: State Supplemental Mid-Level Review Team. A team of volunteers who review completed supplementals before the member submits to national. The second set of eyes that every supplemental needs to improve the quality of our supplementals sent to DC.

Supp: Supplemental Application: Application completed by a member of the DAR to document her descent from a second, third, fourth.... Patriot. The same application and standards apply as the membership application.

VG: Volunteer Genealogists Committee. This committee oversees assigning volunteer genies to help chapters. <u>Mission of the Committee | Daughters of the American Revolution (dar.org)</u>

VST: Virtual Support Teams. This is a phone or virtual one on one help for applications and supplementals. The LRC handles VST for new member applications. The VG committee oversees VST for supplementals. There is a form to request help and a form for GEP III grads to volunteer assistance.
