The Judd Smith Brooks Scholarship \$ 1,000

>Proof of enrollment in a two or four-year accredited college or university shall be required

The Elizabeth M. Hill Kessler Scholarship \$ 926.58

The recipient shall show acceptable scholastic ability, show financial need, be a citizen of the United States of America and be eligible for membership in DAR.

The Gladys E. Routh Memorial Scholarship \$ 1,356.71

Awarded to a deserving boy or girl, preferably ¼ Pottawatomie Indian. Another American Indian heritage may be substituted if there are no applicants from the Pottawatomie tribe. >Attendance at an accredited college or university is required

The Scholarship Committee does work with the Scholarship Director of the Potawatomi Nation Tribe, Mayetta, Kansas to identify a qualified student, who meets the established criteria of the scholarship's original grantor.
