The Members Course provides an opportunity for members to learn more about DAR and how to become an active and engaged participant in DAR at all levels — chapter, state, and national.

The Members Course is open to all DAR members in good standing who actively attend chapter meetings.

To be eligible, members must:

- Subscribe to the American Spirit magazine
- Complete the course within one (1) year of the first module completed and turned in.

The Members Course consists of 23 modules, 12 elective modules, an Independent Project, and a Final Review. All modules are located on the DAR Members website www.DAR.org/members under Committees. Each module takes about 30 minutes to complete (some less some more). In addition, you will need to participate in Meetings/Tours/Activities. These include things like Chapter Meetings, a State Meeting, District workshops, or perhaps a Flag Retirement Ceremony. You will then complete a questionnaire for each activity chosen. Also required is an Independent Project. This could be something you have special interest in, such as organizing a tour for your chapter to a historic site or organizing a fund-raiser. There are numerous opportunities and I am here to help you with ideas. Lastly, you will complete the Graduation Final Review. Once you have completed the course, your Independent Project and Graduation Final Review are submitted to NSDAR. All graduates will be honored at a KSDAR graduation. You will then be eligible to purchase a Leadership Training Pin and Members Course Bar from the DAR Insignia Store. You may also order a Cockade KSDAR Cockade 4 (2022).pub (kansasdar.org)
