The 2024 Membership Initiatives (see NSDAR website and the Daughters Online Community for details):

FOR EVERY CHAPTER – Embark on an adventure: Discover treasured gems and sparkling DAR futures! 2 membership initiatives in one (you can do one or both).

- **DISCOVER TREASURED GEMS** – Bring in 4 or more new members by application or reinstatement during 2024. Reinstatements must be for members inactive for two years or more.

AND/OR

- **SPARKLE MORE IN '24** – Bring in 1 more new member by application than you did the year before.

FOR CHAPTERS WITH 50 OR FEWER MEMBERS (as of January 1, 2024) – One Gem, Two Gems! Can You Find More?

- Chapters can earn the opportunity to have their name entered into a drawing for a \$150 gift certificate to the DAR store to use toward the purchase of chapter supplies. There will be 76 certificates drawn.
- For every two new members by application that the chapter has, they will be entered into a drawing for the gift certificate.
- A chapter may be entered more than once. Ex. If they have 6 new members then they would be entered 3 times.
- The new member count will run from January 1, 2024 to November 5, 2024.
- Transfers and reinstatements do not count as a new member
