

THE NATIONAL AMERICA 250 COMMISSION established on July 22, 2016. And was enacted by the House of Representatives and Senate, President Barack Obama signed Public Law 114-196, creating the United States Semiquincentennial Commission. Congress established the Commission "to provide for the observance and commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the founding of the United States and related events through local, State, national, and international activities planned, encouraged, developed, and coordinated by a national commission representative of appropriate public and private authorities and organizations."

The Act instituted a congressional commemorative commission composed of 33 members with 24 members appointed by the House and Senate leaders on a bipartisan basis and nine heads of federal agencies designated as nonvoting ex officio members.

AMERICA 250 KANSAS COMMISSION

During the 2022 legislative session, the Legislature passed a bill creating the Kansas Commission for the United States Semiquincentennial (K.S.A. 74-50, 292).



In 2023, the Commission identified its official name, Kansas 250, and then partnered with Kansas Tourism to create its logo and tagline, "Per Aspera".

The Commission was established within the Department of Commerce with the purpose to plan, encourage, develop and coordinate the commemoration of the 250th anniversary of the founding of the United States and to recognize the impact of this event on the people of Kansas and the nation's past, present and future.

On July 4, 2026, America celebrates its semiquincentennial, the commemoration of the 250-year anniversary since the signing of the Declaration of Independence. America 250 Kansas will celebrate America turning 250 years old by sharing the triumphs and the difficulties Kansans faced when settling the heartland.

Our state motto, "Ad Astra Per Aspera" or "To the Stars,
Through Difficulties," recognizes our ambitions and the
difficult challenges Kansans have overcome to make Kansas the great
state she is today.

That's why we have chosen "Per Aspera" as the unifying theme of our celebrations.

We are planning celebrations across our state, and your are an important part of these efforts. You, your community, and the organizations to which you belong can play a vital role in this nationwide celebration. We encourage you to follow our efforts as well as create your own local events. 
